



Care Instructions: Draperies

Koni draperies will maintain their original beauty for a long time if cared for properly. For best results, **KONI recommends using annual professional cleaning services.**

If internal drapery cleaning is required for draperies made of polyester and poly/cotton, Koni recommends using a professional cleaning service.

Drapery care

- Remove the dust by vacuuming the draperies monthly without removing the drapes from hardware.

Dry Cleaning

- Dry cleaning is recommended for draperies with caution.
- Use only new or freshly distilled solution. (The use of contaminated solvent may result in browning of the fabric.)

SPOT REMOVER:

Apply Koni PreClean spot remover to the spot and gently rub it into the fabric. Let it sit for 10 minutes. Hand wash the spot in lukewarm water, or wash as instructed above. For stubborn stains, brush lightly after applying the spot remover and repeat the process.

NOTE:

Ironing is not necessary if the above instructions are followed. Avoid HEAT, CHLORINE and FABRIC SOFTENERS, they are the fabrics worst enemies.
